**All-Together No; only those who are ingrafted into him, and, receive all his benefits, by a true faith.**

Presider What is true faith?

**All-Together True faith is not only a certain knowledge, whereby I hold for truth all that God has revealed to us in his word, but also an assured confidence, which the Holy Spirit works by the gospel in my heart; that not only to others, but to me also, remission of sin, everlasting righteousness and salvation are freely given by God, merely of grace, only for the sake of Christ's merits.**

Presider What is then necessary for a Christian to believe?

**All-Together All things promised us in the gospel. Which the articles of the Apostle's Creed, our universal undoubted Christian faith and confession, briefly teach us.**
