**Congregation Who can utter the mighty deeds of the LORD, or declare all his praise?**

Presider Blessed be the LORD, the God of Israel, from everlasting to everlasting!

**Altogether And let all the people say, "Amen! Praise the LORD!"**

*The Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 22; Q&A 57-58*

Presider What comfort does the "resurrection of the body" afford you?

**Altogether That not only my soul after this life shall be immediately taken up to Christ its head; but also, that this my body, being raised by the power of Christ, shall be reunited with my soul, and made like unto the glorious body of Christ.**

Presider What comfort do you take from the article of "life everlasting"?

**Altogether That since I now feel in my heart the beginning of eternal joy, after this life, I shall inherit perfect salvation, which "eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither has it entered into the heart of man" to conceive, and that to praise God therein forever.**
