| PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP Altogether

| CALL TO WORSHIP Responsive Reading

Psalm 109:26-28, 30

Presider Help me, O LORD my God! Save me according to your steadfast love!

Congregation Let them know that this is your hand; you, O LORD, have done it!

Presider Let them curse, but you will bless! They arise and are put to shame, but your servant will be glad!

Altogether With my mouth I will give great thanks to the LORD; I will praise him in the midst of the throng.

| CONFESSION OF FAITH * Responsive Reading

The Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 24; Q&A 62-64

Presider But why cannot our good works be the whole, or part of our righteousness before God?

Altogether Because, the righteousness, which can be approved of before the tribunal of God, must be absolutely perfect, and in all respects conformable to the divine law; and also, that our best works in this life are all imperfect and defiled with sin.

Presider What? Do not our good works merit that which God will reward in this and in a future life?

Altogether This reward is not of merit, but of grace.

Presider But does not this doctrine make men careless and profane?

Altogether By no means, for it is impossible that those, who are united to Christ by a living faith, should not bring forth fruits of obedience and thanksgiving.
