God for this end, that by the use thereof, he may the more fully declare and seal to us the promise of the gospel: that he grants us freely the remission of sin, and life eternal, for the sake of

that one sacrifice of Christ, accomplished on the cross.

Presider Are both word and sacraments, then, ordained and appointed for

this end, that they may direct our faith to the sacrifice of Jesus

Christ on the cross, as the only ground of our salvation?
