| PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP Altogether

| CALL TO WORSHIP Responsive Reading
Psalm 111:1-4

Presider Praise the LORD! I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation.

Congregation **Great are the works of the LORD, studied by all who delight in them.**

Presider Full of splendor and majesty is his work, and his righteousness endures forever.

Altogether **He has caused his wonderous works to be remembered; the LORD is gracious and merciful.**

| CONFESSION OF FAITH * Responsive Reading
The Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 25; Q&A 65-68

Presider Since we are made partakers of Christ and all his benefits by faith only, from where does this faith proceed?

Altogether **From the Holy Spirit, who works faith in our hearts by the preaching of the gospel, and confirms it by the use of the sacraments.**

Presider What are the sacraments?

Altogether **The sacraments are holy visible signs and seals, appointed of God for this end, that by the use thereof, he may the more fully declare and seal to us the promise of the gospel: that he grants us freely the remission of sin, and life eternal, for the sake of that one sacrifice of Christ, accomplished on the cross.**

Presider Are both word and sacraments, then, ordained and appointed for this end, that they may direct our faith to the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross, as the only ground of our salvation?

Altogether **Yes, indeed: for the Holy Spirit teaches us in the gospel, and assures us by the sacraments, that the whole of our salvation depends upon that one sacrifice of Christ which he offered for us on the cross.**

Presider How many sacraments has Christ instituted in the new covenant?

Altogether **Two: namely, holy baptism, and the holy supper.**

| PRAYER OF CONFESSION Altogether
O gracious, gentle and condescending God, God of peace, Father of mercy, God of all comfort: we confess before you the evil of our hearts; we acknowledge that we are too inclined toward anger, jealousy, and revenge, to ambition and pride; and too often have we both offended and grieved you. O long-suffering Father, forgive us our sins and permit us to partake of the blessing you have promised the peacemakers, who shall be called the children of God. Through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

| ASSURANCE OF PARDON Responsive
Romans 5:1-2

Presider Since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand; and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God.
